Eye Contact

Skin Contact

Wash off immediately with soap and plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. May cause an allergic skin reaction. In the case of skin irritation or allergic reactions see a physician.

Inhalation

Remove to fresh air. Get medical attention immediately if symptoms occur. Aspiration into lungs can produce severe lung damage. If breathing has stopped, give artificial respiration.
